

Cookie Policy

Introduction

Cookies used on this website (the “Website”) will only contain personal information about you to the extent necessary to improve your experience and help make your visits more effective.

In this cookie policy (the “Policy”), which forms part of our [Privacy Policy](#), we would like to explain more about what cookies do and why we use them.

1. What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file that is downloaded onto your ‘terminal equipment’ (e.g., a computer or smartphone) when you access a website. It allows the website to recognize your device and store some information about your preferences or past actions.

Cookies offer the possibility to identify you and to memorise various information in order to facilitate your navigation on our Website, to ensure the proper functioning of these tools or to make them more effective, for example by memorising your language preferences.

2. What types of cookies exist?

2.1. Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential to enable and facilitate communication by electronic means and provide you with the basic functions of a website, such as a secure log in account or process your online requests. Such cookies do not require your acceptance as they are essential for the proper functioning of a website.

2.2. First-party cookies

Cookies that are set directly by the website you are visiting, i.e., the URL displayed in the browser’s address bar.

2.3. Session cookies

Cookies that expire at the end of a browser session, normally when you exit the browser.

3.4. Third-party cookies

These cookies are set by someone other than the owner of the website. They may be used for functionality, performance, targeting or advertising and social media purposes.

2.5. Persistent cookies

These cookies stay on your computer or device after your browser has been closed and last for a specific period. They can identify who you are for more than one browsing session, for instance, remember your preferences for the next time you visit.

2.6. Functionality cookies

Such cookies, also known as preferences cookies, help personalise a website by remembering your preferences and settings. In particular, these cookies make it possible to memorise the language chosen during your first visit on our Website in order to personalise it accordingly.

2.7. Performance cookies

These cookies help us make sure that the website is working properly and fix any errors.

2.8. Advertising or Marketing cookies

Such cookies show you specially targeted adverts when you visit a website. They allow third party companies to place cookies on websites to track your online activity to help advertisers deliver more relevant advertising or to limit how many times you see an ad. As an example, these cookies remember which users have visited the website and the links they have followed. These cookies can share that information with other organisations or advertisers.

2.9. Analytics cookies

These cookies, also known as statistics cookies are used to gather information about your use of our Website in order to improve the content of our Website, to make it more adapted to your needs and to increase its ease of use.

For example, these cookies show us which pages of the Website are visited most frequently or help to identify any difficulties that may be encountered during the navigation.

3. Which cookies do we use?

The types of cookies used by GVWAY in connection with the Website are described in the table below:

Cookie ID	Type	Category	Duration	Description
NEXT_LOCALE	persistent	Necessary	1 year	This cookie can be set using a language switcher and then when a user comes back to the site it will leverage the locale specified in the cookie when redirecting from/to the correct locale location.
cookieyes-consent	persistent	Functional	1 year	CookieYes sets this cookie to remember users' consent preferences so that their preferences are respected on subsequent visits to this site. It does not collect or store any personal information about the site visitors.
__cfllb	persistent	Necessary	1 hour	This cookie is used for strictly necessary technical purposes: load balancing, and routing by Cloudflare.

_ga	persistent	Analytics	1 year 1 month 4 days	Google Analytics sets this cookie to calculate visitor, session and campaign data and track site usage for the site's analytics report. The cookie stores information anonymously and assigns a randomly generated number to recognise unique visitors.
ga*	persistent	Analytics	1 year 1 month 4 days	Google Analytics sets this cookie to store and count page views.

4. How to delete cookies?

You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, except concerning strictly necessary cookies, as they are essential for the functioning of each website.

The first time you visit our Website, you can submit your cookie preferences by clicking the "*Manage cookies*" button when the cookie banner opens. You will then be redirected to a screen where you can indicate your preferences accordingly. If you wish to change your preferences at a later stage, you can do so by clicking the link to our Cookies Management. The link to our Cookies Management is also available at the footer of every page on the Website. Strictly necessary cookies may be disabled only by changing your browser settings, but this may affect how the Website functions.

You can disable and/or delete cookies via your browser if you wish to, but this will restrict the functions that you're able to carry out. For more information please visit the [About cookies website](#).
